11. 43 % of students put forwarded that the extension and outreach programmes conducted by the institution were good and 4 % of students found it is in average.



12. 42 % of students proposed that the availability of Digital Resources Computer/Internet /Smart class Room with ICT Facility / Wi-Fi were good and 3 % of students denied it.

The autonomous status of our college gives the opportunity to inculcate various skills required by the students to excel in their respective fields. Hence the exit survey from the students were collected to as to know their feedback. From the feed-back we inferred that

**1. The Curriculum has been updated periodically by introducing new courses**

The curriculum followed in our department for our undergraduate and postgraduate students is updated periodically by introducing new courses when and where required. The response from the students is the greatest proof for that. Most of the students (90.5 %) were satisfied to a great extent.

**2. Courses in the Curriculum are suitable for Employability / Entrepreneurship / Skill Development**

Our curriculum is designed in such a manner that not only the employability skills of the students get developed within the students but the entrepreneurial skills also get inculcated within them simultaneously. As a result of which, 81.5 % of our students have given their feedback as excellent for the query to them regarding the suitability of the curriculum for the development of employability/entrepreneurship/skill within them.

**3. Skill oriented / Value added courses offered by your Department**

Updating a syllabus is crucial to its long-term success. Our department faculty members are expert in recent learning technology such as virtual and online platforms. The updated syllabus includes the basic principles and concepts that are fundamental to the subject, some current applications of biology, and a strong emphasis on practical skills. 5. Most of the students said that the classroom preparation by the teacher is up to 52.4% are Good. Some of the students felt that classroom preparation by the teacher is above 33.3% Excellent and only few students have an opinion that the preparation is moderate..
6. 57.1% of the students (12/21) said that the ICT facilities are used by the teacher is Good. 28.6% of the students (6/21) have felt that the usage of ICT facilities are used by teacher is Excellent and only few students have an opinion that is moderate.
7. Most of the students said that evaluation of CIA and semester examination followed by the Institution is upto 61.9% are Good. Some of the students have felt that CIA and semester examination followed by the Institution is above 33.3% are Excellent and only few students have an opinion that enhance CIA and semester examination method are marginally relevant.
8. 57.1% of the students (12/21) said that the Institution followed by the mentoring and counselling system is up to 62.3% are Good. 33.3% of the students (7/21) felt that the

10. 52.4% of the students (11/21) said that the programmes provides opportunity to undergone research activity are Good. 33.3% of the students (7/21) said that an opportunity are Excellent and only few students have an opinion that an opportunity is moderate.
11. Most of the students said that the programmes provide an opportunity to undertake extension activities is above 52.4% are Good. Some of the students felt that an opportunity is upto 28.6% are excellent and only few students have an opinion that the rarely provided an opportunity.
12. 66.7% of the students (14/21) said that an E-Resources available in the Institution are helpful to enrich the knowledge of students. 23.8% of the students (5/21) felt that an E-Resources availability is Excellent and only very few students have an opinion that 9.5% opportunity are given.
13. 52.4% of the students (11/21) said that the facilities provided in the laboratory, Library and Reprographic are Good. 38.1% of the students (8/21) felt that the facilities provided in the laboratory, Library and Reprographic are Excellent and only few students have an opinion that the facilities are moderate.
14. 52.4% of the students (11/21) said that an opportunity to provide scholarship is Good 28.6% of the students (6/21) felt that an opportunity is Excellent and only few students have an opinion that rarely provided .
15. Most of the students said that the Institution provide an opportunity to undergone Placement ,Capacity and skill enhancement is above 52.4% are Good. Some of the students felt that an opportunity is upto 19.0% are Excellent and only few students have an opinion that an opportunity are moderate.

Totally forty two (42 students) responses have been collected from the student, out of which 50% (21) response were “**excellent**”, 40.5% (17) recorded “**good**”, one student ticked “**Average**” this show the responses is highly positive .
- 2. Courses in the curriculum are suitable for Employability / Entrepreneurship / Skill Development**  
It was noticed that, 23students (54.8%) have chosen “**excellent**”, 40.5% (17) have chosen “**good**”, only two students have marked “**average**”, this is also a highly positive feedback.
- 3. Skill oriented/ value added courses offered by your department**  
It was observed that 45.2% (19 students) have ticked “**excellent**”, 40.5% (17students) have chosen “**good**”, whereas 2 students have selected “**satisfactory**”, 2 students ticked “**average**”. This is also good feedback.
- 4. The ambience of the class room is healthy**  
23 students have selected “**excellent**”, and 17 students have chosen the option “**good**”. 2 students have recorded their response as “**satisfactory**”. 3 have ticked “**average**”, the response is favoring positive, and the negative responses are negligible.
- 5. How well did the teacher prepare for the classes and was able to communicate**  
23students (54.8%) have chosen “**excellent**”. 15 students have ticked “**good**”, only two students have marked “**satisfaction**”. This show a highly positive feedback.
- 6. Usage of ICT facilities by the teachers**  
20 students (47.6%) feel that there was a “**excellent**”. 17 students (35.7%) have opted that the choice “**good**”, 2 students (4.5%) have rated as “**satisfactory**”, there are no negative responses.
- 7. Fairness of evaluation method followed for CIA & semester examination**  
50% of the students gave “**excellent**” for CIA evaluation and 40.5% chosen good option.
- 8. Mentoring & counseling system**  
The needs of Mentoring & counseling system, 20out of 42 (47.6 %)have rated it as “**excellent**”, 17 out of 42 (40.5%) have ticked “**good**” and two have chosen “**satisfactory**”, there are 2 and 3responses under “**average and poor**” respectively. This show all the respondents are highly satisfied on this area.

**11. Extension & outreach programmes conducted by the institution (NSS/RRC/YRC/WEW)**

Five points scale of ranking was followed for every question. The following is the analysis and interpretation of the responses.

1. For the question about the periodical Curriculum update by introducing new courses 39% said Excellent, 46% said good, the others said it is satisfactory or average.
2. When asked if the Courses in the Curriculum were suitable for Employability / Entrepreneurship / Skill Development, 30% said it is Excellent, 48% said it is good the others felt it is satisfactory or average.
3. Skill oriented / Value added courses offered by your Department are commented Excellent by 46%, good by 36%, satisfactory or average by the rest of the students.
4. When asked if the ambience of the classroom is healthy, 37% said it is excellent, 45% said it is good and the rest of the students felt average or satisfactory.
5. When asked about the teachers' preparations for the classes and their ability to communicate, 44% said it is Excellent, 40% said it is good and the remaining felt it is average or satisfactory.
6. About the usage of ICT facilities by the teachers, 29% felt it is excellent, 51% felt it is good, the remaining said satisfactory or average.
7. About the Fairness of evaluation method followed for CIA & Semester Examinations 36% felt it is Excellent, 48% felt it is good, the remaining felt it is average or satisfactory.

8. Mentoring and counselling system are excellent in 91% percentage, 8% percentage good and remaining 1% percentage in satisfactory.



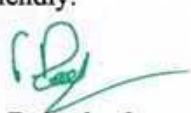

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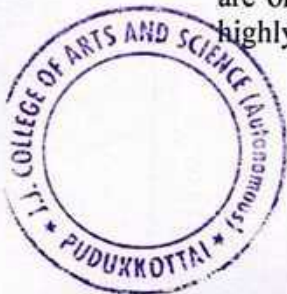

On the basis of availability of digital resources – Computer/ Internet/ Smart classroom with ICT facility/ WiFi. 111 out of which 169 (66%) have ticked Excellent (47) and Good (64), (23) have Satisfactory. There are only (24) respondents ticking Average and Poor (11). Thus, the responses are positive opinion.
13. On the basis of Resources of Laboratory, Library and Reprographic facilities. 112 out of which 169 (66.3%) have opted Excellent (47) and Good (65), (35) have given as Satisfactory. There are only 16 respondents marking Average and Poor (06). So, the responses are positive opinion.
14. Scholarship and Freeships provided by the Institution: (41) have marked as Excellent and (78) as Good and (22) as Satisfactory. There are only 18 respondents marking Average and Poor (10). Thus, 119 out of which 169 (70.41%) have recorded a positive opinion.
15. On the basis of Placement, Capacity development and skill enhancement activities organized. 110 out of which 169 (65.09%) have given as Excellent (52) and as Good (58), 21 have given as Satisfactory. There are 20 respondents giving Average and Poor (18). So, the responses are positive opinion.
16. Redressal of student grievances including Harassment and ragging cases: 128 out of which 169 (75.73%) have opted Excellent (51) and Good (77), (20) have opted satisfactory. There are only 12 respondents ticking Average and Poor (09). Thus, the responses are highly positive.
17. Sports and Cultural events / Competitions organized in the institution: (41) have ticked them as Excellent and (74) as Good and (23) as Satisfactory. There are only 20 respondents marking Average and Poor (11). Thus, 118 out of 169 (70%) have recorded as positive opinion.
18. Helpful attitude of administrators and faculty members: 120 out of which 169 (71%) have ticked Excellent (50) and Good (70), (30) have ticked Satisfactory. There are only 13 respondents ticking Average and Poor (06). Thus, the responses are positively opinion.
19. On the basis of promotion of gender equity: 124 out of which 169 (73.4%) have opted Excellent (49) and Good (75), (26) have opted Satisfactory. There are 12 respondents ticking Average and Poor (07). Thus, the responses are highly positive.
20. On the basis of Campus clean, green and Eco-friendly. (65) have ticked as Excellent and (61) as Good, (27) have ticked as Satisfactory. There are 09 respondents ticking Average and Poor 7. Thus, 126 out of which 169 (75%) have recorded highly positive

**REPORT ON STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY ON OVERALL  
INSTITUTIONAL PERFORMANCE (2022-23)**

The outgoing students (UG and PG) were administered a questionnaire on a five point scale relating to various parameters of quality in higher education. A total of 116 responses were received. The item-wise response is as follows

1. On updation and revision of curricula and courses, 109/116 have given a positive response by ticking 'Excellent' (47), 'Good'(55) or 'Satisfactory'(7). 5 have ticked 'Average' and 2, 'Poor'.
2. On the suitability of the courses offered for employment, entrepreneurship and skill development, 110/116 have a positive opinion. As many as 101 respondents have rated the courses as 'Excellent'(35) or 'Good' (66). 'Average' and 'Poor' have been ticked by 4 and 2 respondents respectively.
3. About the quality of the value added courses offered by the department 107/116 have ticked the positive options – 'Excellent' (40), 'Good'(58), 'Satisfactory' (9). 4 have ticked 'Average' and 5, 'Poor'.
4. On classroom ambience, 105/116 have ticked the positive options- 'Excellent' (44), 'Good' (54), 'Satisfactory' (7). There are very few negative responses (Average- 5, Poor-6)
5. On the fifth query on the level of preparation and communicative ability of the teachers, the distribution of responses is 'Excellent' (44), 'Good'(57), 'Satisfactory'(8), 'Average'(5) and 'Poor'(2). The majority of the respondents (109/116) have given a positive feedback
6. On teachers use of ICT facilities, 109/116 have a positive opinion. There are very few negative responses (Average- 6, Poor-1)
7. On the fairness of the evaluation system also, the majority 110/116 have expressed their satisfaction ('Excellent'- 41, 'Good'-57, 'Satisfactory' – 12). However 3 respondents each have ticked 'Average' and 'Poor'
8. On the Mentoring and Counselling system, the majority (110/116) have ticked the positive options - 'Excellent'(36), 'Good'(64), 'Satisfactory' (10). There are very few negative responses with three respondents each ticking 'Average' and 'Poor'.
9. On the quality and effectiveness of invited lectures, seminars, etc. 109/116 have expressed satisfaction ticking 'Excellent' (49), 'Good' (49) and 'Satisfactory' (11). 3 have ticked 'Average' and 4, 'Poor'.
10. On the availability and utility of research amenities also 107/116 have given a positive response – 'Excellent' (46), 'Good' (54) and 'Satisfactory'(7). Average and Poor have been chosen by 6 and 3 respondents respectively.
11. On the quality of the extension activities 106/116 have ticked 'Excellent'(35), 'Good'(64), 'Satisfactory' (7). However 5 each have rated them 'Average' and 'Poor'



12. On the availability of digital resources and facilities, 106/116 have given positive feedback and only 5 each have chosen 'Average' and 'Poor'

13. Regarding laboratory, library and reprographic facilities also, as many as 107/116 have expressed satisfaction. There are 3 responses under 'Average' and 6, under 'Poor'.

14. 105/116 respondents have given positive feedback on the scholarships and freeships offered by the institution. However there are 5 responses under 'Average' and 6 under 'Poor'

15. On placement and employability initiatives 102/116 have given a positive response choosing 'Excellent' (33), 'Good' (60) or 'Satisfactory' (9). But there are 6 who have ticked 'Average' and 8 others who have chosen the option 'Poor'.

16. With regard to grievance redressal, 111/116 have chosen the positive options – 'Excellent' (46), 'Good' (60) and 'Satisfactory' (5). There are 2 responses under 'Average' and 3 under 'Poor'.

17. Out of the 116 respondents 109 are satisfied with the quality of sports and cultural events organised in the college. Their scoring pattern is 'Excellent' – 39, 'Good' – 64, and 'Satisfactory' – 6. 2 respondents have ticked 'Average' and 5, 'Poor'

18. On the helpful attitude of the staff, 111/116 have ticked the positive options - 'Excellent' – 41, 'Good' – 58, or 'Satisfactory' – 12. There are 2 responses under 'Average' and 3 under 'Poor'.

19. On the promotion of Gender Equity in the campus, 109/116 have scored the positive options - 'Excellent' – 41, 'Good' – 59, or 'Satisfactory' – 9. There are 6 respondents who have ticked 'Average' and 4 who have chosen 'Poor'

20. On the cleanliness and eco-friendly ambience of the campus, 110/116 have a positive opinion. ('Excellent' – 47, 'Good' – 57, or 'Satisfactory' – 6). There are 4 responses under 'Average' and 2 under 'Poor'.

The survey reveals a high degree of satisfaction among the students. But there are a few responses under 'Average' and 'Poor' in every item. This negativity has to be addressed through discrete personal interaction and positive one to one discussion with students past and present. Our mission should be to score 'Excellent' or 'Good' in every item. This calls for constant interaction with all stakeholders and prompt remedial action to ensure cent percent satisfaction.

**Feedback Submitted by 33 Students**  
**Feedback Analysis Report**

As part of students satisfaction survey a questionnaire was issued in Google Form to 63 outgoing students. 33 responses were received and the opinions are tabulated as follows.

7. 91% of students expressed their happiness with the Fairness of Evaluation method followed in CIA and Semester Exam.
8. 79% of students were pleased with the mentoring and counseling system in the Department .
9. As 85% of students had marked positive options , it has been concluded that Guest Lecture Programme was effective.
10. 73% of students were pleased with the availability and utility of resources provided by the department.
11. With the extension and outreach programmes, 55% of students expressed their satisfaction.
12. 58% of students were contented with the availability of digital resources.
13. 79% of students were pleased with the facilities provided in the Laboratory, and Library.
14. With Scholarship and Freeship facilities provided by the institution, 70% were satisfied.



15. Placement and capacity development and Skill Enhancement were good as per the opinion of 73% of the students.
16. 85% of the students expressed contentment with the grievances-redressal mechanism.
17. Sports, Cultural events/Competitions conducted in the institution were applauded by 76% of students.
18. 88% of students were pleased with the helpful attitudes of Administrators and faculty members.
19. 85% of students agreed that there was gender equity in the campus.
20. 85% of students were opined that the Campus was clean, green and eco-friendly.

The feedback is encouraging. In all queries the first three positive responses constitute the majority, percentage-wise. There are very few entries under 'average' and 'poor', where these negative responses are above ten, they would be probed by the department, contacting the respondents through the class tutors to discover if there are any real issues or concrete suggestions.
