- 3.Any other matter.



The Chairman, Ms. S. Selvi chaired the meeting and welcomed all the members to the seventh BoS Meeting. After the brief introduction, the items listed in the agenda were taken up for discussion and the following resolutions were passed.

General Resolutions:

1.As instructed by TANSCHÉ and the Parent University, 75% of the content and structure will be from the Model Syllabus downloaded from the University website. Modifications will be limited to 25%. The guidelines given by UGC-LOCF, TANSCHÉ and the affiliating University will be followed in the syllabus to be finalised and implemented from 2023 -2024.

2.It is resolved to evaluate the syllabus being followed from 2022-2023 on the basis of the first semester results and the feedback received from Teachers ,Students ,Alumni and Employers.

3.It is further resolved to convene meetings of the Board of Studies whenever revisions and modifications are required in the light of experience, feedback and further communications received from the University ,TANSCHÉ and the Government.




It was resolved to


2.Approve the Course Structure and the syllabi for implementation from 2023-2024 presented before the Board. (Appendix-1)

3.Accept and approve the changes to be made in the syllabi introduced in 2022-2023, necessitated by the feedback received from staff and students. (Appendix-2)

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









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4. Continue with the existing question paper patterns and distribution of marks for CIA and End Semester Examinations.

6. Incorporate the suggestions offered in the feedback obtained from outgoing students and staff in April 2023, in the new syllabus to be introduced from 2023-2024.
