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As part of our Autonomy, the Curricula for all Programme have to be revised once in every three years. In this, regard, the Curriculum Structure for the **B.C.A. - 03 Year Programme** and **M.C.A - 02 Year Programme** along with the Syllabus for Semester – I and Semester - II have been revised (R3) in the previous Board of Studies meeting (Meeting No - 10), approved in the Academic Council and implemented from the Academic Year 2023 - 2024 onwards.

This **Eleventh Board of Studies Meeting in Computer Applications** is held on 01.04.2024 at 01.00 p.m. to analyse, assess, modify the existing Structure, also to design the Syllabus from Semester – 3 to Semester - 6 of **B.C.A. Programme** and the Syllabus for Semester – 3 & 4 of **M.C.A. Programme** to be implemented from the ensuing Academic year 2024 – 2025 onwards, pertaining to the approval from the Academic Council of the college.

General Resolutions

1. In his notification No: 1616, dated 10.08.2021, the Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Government of Tamil Nadu, has given the Autonomous Colleges, the freedom to retain / reframe their syllabi, Course Structure etc., in keeping with their perceptions on Institutional / local needs.
2. The College Council at its meeting held on 16.09.2023 resolved that our Institution will gratefully accept the academic freedom and empower the Boards of Studies either to retain or to reframe their Curriculum for various Programme under CBCS and UGC - LOCF.
3. However, the Course Structure for the U.G. & P.G. programme at Institutional level will have to follow a uniform pattern with minor variations depending on the discipline specific needs.
4. It is resolved to modify and follow a total of **43 Courses, 4300 Marks and 141 Credits** for the U.G. Programme and **21 Courses, 2100 Marks and 90 Credits** for the P.G. Programme.

7. In the present revision and modification, the General instructions on Curriculum Design, Course Structure, Uniformity of standards etc., given by the UGC - LOCF, AICTE, NAAC, TANSCHÉ and the Parent University have been scrupulously followed.

8. Following the suggestion given by the Honorable members of the Academic Council in its last meeting, a course on Gender Studies has been included.

9. Resolved to include various online courses like **SWAYAM - MOOCs** with extra credits. The credits thus earned will be reflected in the Cumulative Mark Statement of the students.

Choice Based Credit System

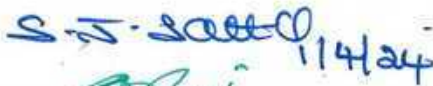
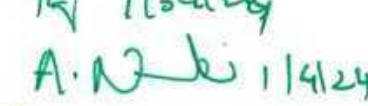
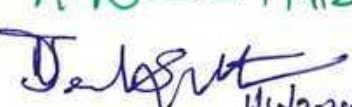
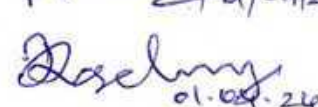
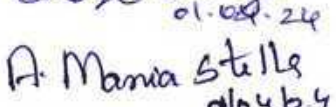
