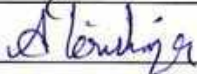
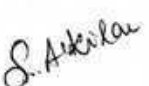

The Chairman, Dr. M. Arumugam chaired the meeting and welcomed all the members to the meeting. After a brief introduction, the members discussed various aspects of the syllabi and the following resolutions were passed.

General Resolutions passed in the BoS Meeting:

1. In his notification No: 1616, dated 10.08.2021, the Chief Secretary, Department of Higher Education, Government of Tamil Nadu, has given the Autonomous Colleges, the freedom to retain / reframe their syllabi, Course Structure etc., in keeping with their perceptions on Institutional / local needs.
2. The College Council at its meeting held on 16.09.2023 resolved that our Institution will gratefully accept the academic freedom and empower the Boards of Studies either to retain or to reframe their Curriculum for various Programmes under CBCS and UGC - LOCF.
3. However, the Course Structure for the U.G. & P.G. programmes at Institutional level will have to follow a uniform pattern with minor variations depending on discipline specific needs.
4. It is resolved to modify and follow a total of 43 courses, 4300 marks and 141 credits for the U.G. Programmes and 21 courses, 2100 marks and 90 credits for the P.G. Programmes.

5. The Revised Syllabus has been implemented from the Academic Year 2023 – 2024 onwards. In the previous Boards of Studies meeting, the Syllabus for first two Semesters have been passed. Now in the light of the Government Communication, cited in Point No. 1, the Chairmen of the Boards of Studies have introduced some changes in the Syllabus for Semester I and Semester II. Such modifications are approved and passed by this Board.
6. The Course Structure mentioned in Point No: 4 for U.G. & P.G. Programmes have already been approved.
7. In the present revision and modification, the General instructions on Curriculum Design, Course Structure, Uniformity of standards etc., given by the UGC - LOCF, AICTE, NAAC, TANSCH and the Parent University have been scrupulously followed.
8. Following the suggestion given by the Honorable members of the Academic Council in its last meeting, a course on Gender Studies has been included in all UG programmes.
9. Resolved to include various online courses like SWAYAM - MOOCs with extra credits. The credits thus earned will be reflected in the Cumulative Mark Statement of the students.
10. Resolved to continue offering Value Added Courses.
11. Implement the following guidelines on Curriculum Design given by NAAC
 - a. Specific mention has been made of Programme Outcomes (POs), Programme Specific Outcomes (PSOs), Course Outcomes (Cos), Programme Educational Objectives (PEOs) and Course Objectives (Cos) in the syllabus.
 - b. Relationship Matrix for CO, PO and PSO for all the courses implemented.
 - c. Curriculum addresses local, Regional, National and Global needs.
 - d. Courses also focus on Gender, Environment and Sustainability, Human values and Professional Ethics.
