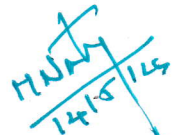
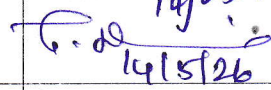

1. Resolved to follow the revised UG and PG curriculum, in accordance with the guidelines of UGC-LOCF, NAAC, TANSCH and the Parent University.
2. Resolved to follow the Curriculum, Course Structure (Syllabi) and textbooks recommended for implementation from the academic year 2026-2027 onwards.
3. Resolved to follow the General Course Structure for the B.A and M.A English Programmes, along with the syllabi for the first two semesters, were discussed and scrutinized for implementation from the academic year 2026-27 onwards.
4. Resolved to approve the following proposed course structure for UG and PG Programmes respectively.

5. Resolved to adopt the changes made in the curriculum based on the feedback received from all stake holders on the existing curricula, courses and Syllabi.
6. Resolved to adopt the revised Bloom's Taxonomy in framing the Course Outcomes.
7. Resolved to incorporate the following new guidelines on Curriculum Design prescribed by NAAC.
 - a. The curriculum framework has been aligned with OBE by defining POs, COs & PEOs/PSOs.
 - b. Generic Open Elective Courses for UG and PG Programmes have been designed in alignment with the CBCS to ensure curriculum flexibility.
 - c. Practical and Industry focused field work/project and Internship Training have been incorporated into the curriculum.
 - d. Skill oriented courses offered by the departments are aligned with NCrf, NSQF, and NHEQF.
 - e. Greater focus has been given to incorporating components of Indian Knowledge Systems into the curriculum.
 - f. Online courses for UG and PG through SWAYAM/SWAYAM PLUS have been incorporated into the curriculum.

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- g. A relationship matrix mapping for COs, POs and PSOs has been implemented for all courses.
 - h. The Curriculum addresses local, regional, national and global needs.
 - i. Courses focus on Employability, Entrepreneurship and Skill Development.
 - j. Courses also emphasize Gender, Environment and Sustainability, Human Values and Professional Ethics.
8. Resolved to include a self-learning course from SWAYAM/SWAYAMPLUS for the UG programme in the IV semester, carrying two credits and 100 marks, and a subject related self learning course offering by the department in the V Semester also carrying two credits and 100 marks.
 9. Resolved to allow that, in the fourth semester, if a student is unable to complete the SWAYAM course, the student shall be permitted to take an optional course offered by the Department under the self-learning category only in the final semester.
