Form Massive Human Chain against Drug Abuse

132 Students and 10 Faculty Members Unite in Powerful Awareness Drive

Linking Campus to Pudukkottai Main Road

PUDUKKOTTAI, AUG 07, 2026: In a resolute effort to safeguard youth and educate the public on the devastating societal and personal impacts of substance abuse, a massive **Anti-Drug Awareness Human Chain demonstration** was successfully conducted at J.J. College of Arts and Science (Autonomous), Pudukkottai. The impactful campaign was organized under the leadership of Dr. G. Manigandan, **Nodal Officer for the Anti-Drug Club** and Head of the Department of Biotechnology. The **human chain** stretched along the main arterial pathway connecting the college campus premises directly to the main road, sending a resounding message to commuters and local society.

A total of **132 enthusiastic students** from the Department of Biotechnology, accompanied by 10 dedicated faculty members, participated in forming the solid human chain. Demonstrators held prominent banners reading "**Say NO to Drugs, Say YES to Life**" and displayed informative placards highlighting the severe physical, mental, and social consequences of narcotics. By occupying the prime stretch between the inner campus and the public main road, the participants successfully engaged passersby and commuters, driving strong public consciousness about building a drug-free environment.

Manigandan** emphasized that creating active, visible street-level awareness is essential to shielding the student community from addiction hazards.
